# The DeutschlandTicket: Buy in the VRR – travel nationwide.

Going anywhere in Germany by bus or train, without having to think about city or transport network boundaries? Protecting the climate and environment at the same time? That's become really easy.

The new DeutschlandTicket for EUR 49 per month is available as a chip card or a digital ticket on your smartphone. You can purchase the DeutschlandTicket via the VRR App, the transport companies' apps, at the KundenCenters, or at the sales outlets in your area. It gives you a flat rate for local public transport that lets you use buses and trains anywhere in Germany whenever, wherever, and as often as you like.



# Who can profit from the DeutschlandTicket?

The DeutschlandTicket is useful if you travel by bus and train in the VRR, in NRW, or even nationwide. It is cheaper than the prior VRR subscription tickets or monthly tickets at price levels A, B, C, or D. It is particularly suitable for commuters and frequent travellers who prefer to cover longer distances by bus and train. The DeutschlandTicket is a personalised ticket that cannot be transferred to any other persons.

## Do you already have a subscription ticket?

Please contact your transport company or sales service provider if you would like to swap your existing Aboticket for a DeutschlandTicket. The convenient swap for the DeutschlandTicket is possible at any time.

**Good to know:** You cannot transfer any transport rights (e.g., for passengers or bicycles) from your present subscription to the DeutschlandTicket.



# Did you prefer travelling by car so far?

Leave the rising energy and fuel prices and the increasing traffic jams behind for good: The DeutschlandTicket pays off for anyone who wants to do without their car more frequently to travel by public transport in the VRR, anywhere in NRW, or even nationwide. The DeutschlandTicket keeps you mobile throughout Germany around the clock at a fixed monthly fee.

## What does the DeutschlandTicket cost?

The DeutschlandTicket is available as a subscription for EUR 49 per month. It will keep you mobile anywhere in Germany for an average of just EUR 1.61 a day.

Stay flexible exactly as your individual mobility needs require. The ticket can be terminated every month by the 10th day of the month without incurring a handling fee; termination will be effective at the end of the month.



# What kinds of public transport will you be able to use?



You can use any type of public transport vehicles in Germany, i.e., buses, trams, city trains, and underground trains as well as city trains, regional trains, and regional express trains in 2nd class carriages. The DeutschlandTicket cannot be used for any long-distance services (e.g., ICE, IC, EC) or for private providers, such as FlixTrain.

# When can you travel?



The DeutschlandTicket lets you travel anywhere in Germany around the clock, 365 days a year. The DeutschlandTicket does not allow you to take along companion passengers. Children under the age of six can be taken along free of charge. A separate ticket is only needed from age six onwards.

# How does ticket inspection work?



Simply present the QR code from the app or your chip card and photo ID at a ticket inspection.

# Supplemental tickets

## Bike Ticket

You will need a monthly bicycle ticket or the bicycle subscription ticket for rides in the VRR if you want to take along your bicycle.

It can be purchased in addition to the DeutschlandTicket for EUR 29 a month. It will be valid for transporting your bicycle anywhere in the VRR for one month. Furthermore, you can buy a VRR FahrradTicket for individual rides with a bicycle. It will be valid for 24 hours following validation..

The FahrradTicket NRW can be used for bicycle transport outside the VRR.

## 1<sup>st</sup>-class ticket

You can purchase a monthly 1st class ticket or a 1st class subscription ticket in addition to your DeutschlandTicket for an additional 46 euros per month. It will be valid for 1st class rides anywhere in the VRR for one month. Furthermore, you can buy the VRR ZusatzTicket for individual 1st class rides in the VRR.

# What is the mobility guarantee?

If your bus or train is delayed at the departure stop by at least 20 minutes, you can travel directly to your actual destination by IC, EC, or ICE or by taxi or a sharing service. The costs for using any taxis or sharing systems will be reimbursed prorated, at up to EUR 30 during the day and up to EUR 60 between 8 pm and 5 am at night per person.

<b>Bicycle transport</b>	Yes, with a monthly bicycle ticket or a bicycle subscription ticket (only valid in the VRR)
<b>Taking along a dog</b>	Yes (NRW)
<b>Mobility guarantee</b>	Yes, reimbursement of costs in case of delays - up to EUR 30.00 between 5 am and 8 pm. - up to EUR 60.00 between 8 pm and 5 am.
<b>Sale</b>	at the KundenCenter, as an eTicket on a chip card, in the VRR and transport company apps, in the ticket shop as a digital ticket
